WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

BELOVED OF GOD, realize this: God, in His infinite wisdom has kept you alive for ONE REASON: *the praise of His glory!* In translation, this means, so long as you are on spiritual course, every heartache, every misfortune, every suffering in your life is God-orchestrated to bring about the BIG PICTURE, *the praise of His glory!* This too explains why James, unapologetically, exhorts his readers: "Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, that you may be perfect [mature] and complete, lacking in nothing" (James 1:2-4). Your spiritual maturity in all aspects is for *the praise of His glory.* Listen, God has a special

ministry for you — it's a ministry of encouragement. Yes, the ministry of encouragement! The ministry of encouragement is not optional; it's a mandate! "Encourage one another day after day" (Hebrews 3:13). Remember, you cannot be an effective encourager until your encouragement comes from a reservoir of experiences! You cannot encourage others with passion, love and tenderness until you too have experienced the true encouragement that comes from God alone.

Blessed [Praised] *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassions, and God of all encouragement; who encourages us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to encourage those who are in any tribulation whatever, through the encouragement with which we ourselves are encouraged of God. Because, even as the sufferings of the Christ abound towards us, so through the Christ does our encouragement also abound. But whether we are in tribulation, *it is* for your encouragement and salvation, wrought in the endurance of the same sufferings which we also suffered (2 Corinthians 1:3-6, 1890 Darby Bible).

You see, with the above passage in mind, we can have a deeper appreciation of Hebrews 2:16-18,

For it is clear that he did not come to help angels, but the descendants of Abraham. Therefore he [Jesus Christ] had to become like his brothers and sisters in every respect, so that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make a sacrifice of atonement for the sins of the people. Because he himself was tested by what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested. (Hebrews 2:16-18, The New Revised Standard Version).

MY BELOVED, think of it! Today, we have the Great High Priest, our Savior Jesus Christ, who, faithfully, 24/7, 365 days a year petitions on our behalf before His Father with an indescribable compassion with regard to our suffering. He does this so well, because He Himself has been there, seen trials, tasted tribulations, and in full measure, endured every kind of suffering that there is! He went through all this like no other, "*so that he might be a merciful and faithful*

KING DAVID, A SYMPHONY OF GOD'S GRACE

God's Faithfulness Highlighted

Blessed [Praised] be the Lord, who daily bears our burden, The God who is our salvation. God is to us a God of deliverances; And to GOD the Lord belong escapes from death.” (Psalm 68:19-20).

What a relief to know that **God will fulfill His Word, not because of who and what we are, but because of Who and What He is.** We cannot state it enough!

Failure to live up to His Word would be the same as destroying His essence. On the other hand, failure to live up to His Word would delight Satan who, in desperation, attacks God's Word from every angle. He falsely hopes that one day he will be able to invalidate God's promise, and thus make

Him a liar. Let's simplify this for easy digestion: one failure of God to keep His Word would cancel the entire Word of God! My beloved, this explains why our Lord was adamant concerning the Father's faithfulness. In view of this we read our Lord's Word afresh,

‘For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass from the Law [the whole realm of God's Word], until all is accomplished.’ (Matthew 5:18).

That too, explains why Jeremiah assures us that God is watching over His Word like a hawk to ensure that no part of His Word would ever fail (Jeremiah 1:12; cf. Numbers 23:19).

The LORD said to me, “You have seen correctly, for I am watching to see that my word is fulfilled.” (Jeremiah 1:12 NIV).

high priest in the service of God.” Suffering was inevitable for our brethren who went before us. Think of the book of Job! What a book of encouragement it has been for millions of God's children in every generation! On the one hand, it's a book of encouragement because Job went through hell on earth. On the other hand, it's a source of great comfort to us all because of the immense faithfulness of God written on every page of this time tested book. Job suffered, but God saw him through! For this reason, he could in his day, confidently sit by the side of anyone who might be going through tough times and say to the individual, “Consider my own suffering, how I lost everything that I had, children, wealth and even health; consider the outcome—a double portion back (Job 42:12-17)!”

He can confidently say to the individual “My God is the same, yesterday, today, yes forever; what He did for me, He can do for you too!” That's encouraging!

SO MY BELOVED ONE, whatever you are going through right now, just remember His promises to you:

‘For I know the plans that I have for you,’ declares the Lord, ‘plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope.’ (Jeremiah 29:11);

‘Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine! When you pass through the waters [of austere measures], I will be with you; And through the rivers [of loss — of employment, of loved ones, etc], they will not overflow you. When you walk through the fire [of suffering], you will not be scorched, Nor will the flame burn you. For I am the Lord your God ...’ (Isaiah 43:1b-3a).

Do you believe all this? If so, go about your business, for

Weeping may last for the night, But a shout of joy comes in the morning. (Psalm 30:5b).

God is walking you through your trials and sufferings so that you can in turn encourage that brother, that sister who may be down and gloomy! Hang on; your ministry is for *the praise of His glory!*

Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to be of the same mind with one another according to Christ Jesus, so that with one accord you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 15:5-6).

My beloved, it's my fervent prayer that the God of encouragement may encourage you through these words!

God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill? (Numbers 23:19) NIV.

A man of many friends comes to ruin, But there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother (Proverbs 18:24).

That's right; no part of His word will ever fail! What a solace for all of us who believe! On the one hand, God made an unbreakable promise to David. On the other hand Satan, through Saul, worked around the clock to cancel that promise. In reflection of God's faithfulness, David sings,

For the word of the LORD is upright; And all His work is done in [perfect] faithfulness. For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast. The Lord nullifies the counsel of the nations; He frustrates the plans of the peoples. The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart from generation to generation (Psalm 33:4, 9-11).

Job echoes,

"I know that You can do all things; **And that no purpose of Yours can be thwarted**" (Job 42:2).

Saul made yet another attempt to thwart God's plan with regard to David; but God would as usual frustrate Saul's effort to kill God's chosen one.

David Escapes Saul's Plot to Kill Him

Now Saul told Jonathan his son and all his servants to put David to death. But Jonathan, Saul's son, greatly delighted in David (1 Samuel 19:1)

Read it again: "But Jonathan, Saul's son, greatly delighted in David." On the other hand, people whose hearts are steeped in evil "Are like the tossing sea, For it cannot be quiet, And its waters toss up refuse and mud" (Isaiah 57:20). Saul's hatred toward David had shot beyond the boiling point. Murder, as we know, made the list of one of the seven sins that are most abhorrent to God (Proverbs 6:16-19). Saul wants David dead without delay. But to Saul's disadvantage, his son, Jonathan is David's closest friend, closer than a brother. Solomon tells us,

Jonathan and David fall into this highest category of friendship. Jonathan loved David as he loved himself (1 Samuel 18:1). He too is a lad of integrity. He is acutely aware, that by the order of primogeniture (the firstborn son receives the inheritance) he, Jonathan, would be the next king of Israel after his father. Armed with that knowledge, he is equally aware that God's grace is upon David beyond measure; and that more than likely, David will be the next king. He was not envious of David; he was not poisoned with jealousy. Rather he was happy for his friend (1 Samuel 20:12-16). My beloved, that's maximum integrity, a trait rare among Christians today. Much more, God would use Jonathan as a messenger to safeguard David's life. We read,

God had already made the provision before the beginning of time. That is what grace is all about — never earned, never deserved.

So Jonathan told David saying, "Saul my father is seeking to put you to death. Now therefore, please be on guard in the morning, and stay in a secret place and hide yourself (1 Samuel 19:2).

Saul is breathing hatred for David. By contrast his son, Jonathan, loves David dearly and would be an advocate for him. David didn't need to look for an advocate; for God had already made the provision before the beginning of time. That's what grace is all about—never earned, never deserved. Jonathan went straight to his father, to plead David's case. Hence we read,

Then Jonathan spoke well of David to Saul his father, and said to him, 'Do not let the king sin against his servant David, since he has not sinned against you, and since his deeds have been very beneficial to you. For he took his life in his hand [literally he risked his life] and struck the Philistine [i.e. Goliath], and the

Lord brought about a great deliverance for all Israel; you saw it and rejoiced. Why then will you sin against innocent blood by putting David to death without a cause?' (1 Samuel 19:4-5).

Jonathan's argument won Saul's heart, but just for the moment (1 Samuel 19:6). Seeing Saul's change of heart, Jonathan requests his beloved friend, David, to continue his therapeutic music service to his father (1 Samuel 19:7). On top of this, during the time David was providing his heartfelt service to Saul, he went and defeated the Philistines who posed another threat to Saul's kingdom (1 Samuel 19:8). We know that David could only be in one place at any given time. In his absence, Saul's condition (under demonic attacks) had deteriorated. David would again experience another premeditated murder attempt upon his life following his return from defeating the Philistines. We pick up the story from the next verse,

Now there was an evil spirit from the Lord on Saul as he was sitting in his house with his spear in his hand [bad combination—evil spirit and spear in hand], and David was playing the harp with his hand. And Saul tried to pin David to the wall with the spear, but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, so that he stuck the spear into the wall. And David fled and escaped that night (1 Samuel 19:9-10).

Surprised? Not at all! Not if you take God's Word at its face value. First, let me say this: A believer in perpetual carnality (going from sin to sin — never confessing) is always at the mercy of the power of the Sin Nature. He is never stable in his ways; he cannot be rational; nor can anyone trust him. There is no sin under the sun which the carnal believer cannot commit. That's Saul condition. He was unstable. He was of sound mind yesterday; today he is ready to commit murder. What a miserable life to live! Second, David escaped, not because of his maneuvering skill; rather because escape from death belongs to God (Psalm 68:20). David was not going to be killed by anyone until God's plan for his life came to a perfect completion (Acts 13:36). That goes for you too, my beloved. You can sleep comfortably tonight knowing this biblical truth! David, escaped, but Saul's instability re-

mains unchanged. He intensifies his quest for David's death. He would now involve everyone in an all out war to get David.

All Out War to Kill David

Then Saul sent messengers to David's house to watch him, in order to put him to death in the morning. But Michal, David's wife, told him, saying, 'If you do not save your life tonight, tomorrow you will be put to death' (1 Samuel 19:11).

Was David's marrying of Michal, Saul's daughter, an accident? No! Accidents do not exist in God's plan. Being in the right relationship at the right time, God would use Michal to guard the life of his servant

David. She helped him escape through their window and fooled Saul's messengers (19:12-16). Saul was not happy with his daughter's cleverness. The bottom line is that David escaped unharmed. The sobering lesson for us all is that we should avoid dangers when we are aware of them. The Lord did the same. David could have said, "Nay, the Lord of the armies is with me; what would man do

to me?" That would have been tantamount to tempting God. David simply escaped and went to Samuel. Both went and stayed at Naioth, Ramah. David had run away; supposedly that should end Saul's pursuit. Right? Wrong again! Saul asked his messengers to go after him in Naioth. Saul is not resting because he has become an instrument in the hands of the restless one, Satan, who is working tirelessly to make God a liar. To do this, Satan plans to use Saul to kill David before he's crowned king. God's sense of humor awaits Saul's messengers at Ramah.

Saul's Messengers Prophecy

It was told Saul, saying, 'Behold, David is at Naioth in Ramah.' Then Saul sent messengers to take David, but when they saw the company of prophets prophesying, with Samuel standing and presiding over them, the Spirit of God came upon the messengers of Saul; and they also prophesied" 1 Samuel (19:19-20).

Amazing? Yes. Our God is a God of amazement. He's not finished with His humor. Saul sent yet another group; he also lost them to the group of prophets; for they too prophesied. Saul, lost his mind and sent another group, they too joined the rest and prophesied (1 Samuel 19:21-22). Scripture is silent with regard to what they prophesied about. But for the fun of it, I think their prophecy was something like this: "God is finished with Saul; David is the next king on the horizon—Amen!"

Guess what? Apparently Saul called his messengers losers who did not know how best to maneuver around the sovereignty of God. This time, he took the matter into his own hands; Saul went himself to see what was happening at Ramah. Go, he did! But does God have a surprise for Saul. He too met the power of the Omnipotent God. God's sense of humor is unequalled! Beloved of God, our Father God is BIGGER than we are; His plan is SUPERIOR to ours, while ours may fail; God's plan WILL NOT and CANNOT fail. God's sovereignty guarantees it! Who is Saul kidding? The God of the universe? Not a chance! God would meet Saul with the endowment of His Spirit and he too would prophesy.

Then he himself went to Ramah and came as far as the large well that is in Secu; and he asked and said, 'Where are Samuel and David?' And someone said, 'Behold, they are at Naioth in Ramah.' He proceeded there to Naioth in Ramah; and the Spirit of God came upon him also, so that he went along prophesying continually until he came to Naioth in Ramah. He also stripped off his clothes, and he also prophesied before Samuel and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Therefore they say, 'Is Saul among the prophets?' (1 Samuel 22-24).

No, he wasn't among the prophets; yet he was made so temporarily. This experience was enough to learn that God's promise shall not be broken!

My beloved, it's totally sensational, walking through David's journey from beginning to end, to behold how remarkably God graced him out in all respects. Incredible indeed! David was just a lad, taking care of his father-Jesse's flock when God's grace hit him right between the eyes and made him a chosen vessel. We saw how God delivered him from dangerous animals, the bear and the lion (1 Samuel 17:34-37). And here we are beholding afresh God's rescue after rescue of his servant David from a barrage of pursuit by Saul. This underscores our title, *David, a Symphony of God's Grace*.

MISSIONARY REPORTS

CAPE VERDE — November 2009

Moses was able to spend two weeks in the Islands of Cape Verde off the western coast of North Africa. Three different islands were visited and the people were taught the Grace of God and Salvation by faith alone in Christ alone. An outdoor crusade was also held at the first venue. In the last venue the pastor gave his entire church and congregation over to Moses for the whole day! They were so hungry for the word and want to know when Moses can return!

After attending the Bible-based Pastors Conference the pastors said “This has not been done here in 20 years!” They also reported “This is the first time in history that the pastors have come together!” WOW!

There is lots of idolatry in the land — but now there is HOPE! We thank God for what He is doing and give Him all the glory.

LIBERIA — November 2009

Pastor Jackson hosted us for a Pastor’s conference and an open air crusade for 3 days in Liberia. For the first time he heard the gospel of salvation by faith alone in Christ alone. He said “I think you have come here just for me. For 30 years I have been a pastor and I have not know this Truth — today I was saved when I heard Rev, Moses teach!”

We also held a crusade in an area near a hill where sacrifices were offered. An area where people are still caught in the tribal religions, where the light of the gospel had not yet shined.

Pastor Jackson’s testimony speaks louder than any words I could write:

“Indeed, it was a blessing to have the team here in Liberia for the conference and the crusade. If you would not have come thousands of souls were going to be lost without the truth. I personally received the most important thing in life by knowing the truth. For so many years I have been in darkness without the truth. I am therefore grateful to Pastor Moses and every one of you who made it possible for him to come to Liberia with such a powerful message which has brought light to us. It is our prayer that the Lord opens the door for you to come again, if not next year the following year. We are indeed blessed by the true words from the Bible.”

“Meanwhile, we wish to extend our heartfelt gratitude to you all for responding to our call and coming to Liberia. May the Lord richly bless you all in Jesus name. We also appreciate the free books you gave to each of the pastors and church workers.”

PAKISTAN — January 2010

Moses’ visa was denied but he “visited” the people via a live web connection.

Pastor Azam reported:

Pastor Azam hosted two conferences in Pakistan. At the first venue he played a video that he had taped with Pastor Bruce Bumgardner earlier this year. Moses called to greet the pastors while the conference was in session and all 250 pastors cheered.

The pastors loved the Bruce/Azam DVD’s so much they begged Pastor Azam to stay for two more days. Azam advised the pastors they can continue the lessons as they play on cable each day at 7 a.m.

Azam held programs in the second venue with a live address via the internet from Moses. He had it set up so Moses could be viewed speaking live on a big screen in Pakistan and Moses could also see the audience there. They met for two days via live teleconference. It was amazing to watch as the Lord has guided and provided so the people of Pakistan could be fed even though a visa was denied! What a testimony to the faithfulness of God.

Pastor Khalid reported:

The people were so excited and because they knew Moses, and now they could see Moses on the big screen, they felt he was really with them.

Khalid distributed *Comfort in Suffering* translated in Urdu. One man in attendance said “after receiving the Book *Comfort in Suffering* I at once started to study the book and I felt in my spirit satisfaction and peace because I was in need of these words that day due to my worries. I could not sleep that same night and made good decision and came unto Jesus for divine power.”

Another testimony from the conference.

“A popular Christian keyboardist in our town came to church on and off because he was angry with some church leaders. But after attending the online (Skype) seminar of Rev. Moses about love, his heart was broken in the session and he confessed and repented of his mistake before the Lord Jesus Christ and

he asked forgiveness of the church leaders. Now he is happy and good at all his church activities. He shared his testimony and all the people were blessed.”

Moses addressed the people via video conference for three days. The people were so hungry to hear the messages that at the end of day two when Moses said “Let us pray” a huge shout of protest went up — they did not want to stop learning!

U.A.E. — January 2010

Moses returned to the U.A. E. to continue teaching grace doctrine. Pastor Azam traveled with Moses and translated. He reported “Moses gave words of encouragement and then explained ‘Why the Bible is unique compared to other religious books.’ People were listening to Moses so carefully with smiles on their faces. After the meeting I met people and asked their views about the preaching of the night and they said ‘FANTASTIC.’”

Pastor Azam could not get a visa to Qatar so he visited other pastors in the U.A.E. to arrange meetings for next year while Moses went on to Qatar.

QATAR — January 2010

Moses visited the people of Qatar for the first time. Pastor Peter was his host there. Before their first meeting a congregation of Filipinos found out Moses was in town and they asked him to visit their congregation. So Moses was able to minister in two separate congregations on day one!

Pastor Azam sent this report: “Thanks to God, He is using Moses to glorify Himself in Qatar. Last night when I asked Rev. Peter about Moses first meeting he was very excited and laughing and said ‘brother Moses is great man of God.’ As you know when Moses start preaching eyes are fixed on him.”

“It was the first chance for the Qatar church to get the taste of the Word of God and they were so happy. I asked Peter what was the people’s view after the preaching and he said ‘Brother, people like him very much.’ God is moving in Qatar through Moses and lives are changing there and people are rejoicing with the anointing of God’s Word there.”

On the last day — as Moses prepared to travel — they just had to have more teaching. After insisting, Moses hurriedly packed and they hosted him for dinner on his way to the airport! They asked for more teaching to clear up some areas of legalism and grace. They simply could not get enough of this Truth. They begged him to come back this year — even if just for one day.

NIGERIA — February 2010

This mission report would not be complete without sharing the story and amazing testimony of the faith unto death of our brother in Christ, John. He was a member of the Bible Study group at the G.E.M. Africa headquarters, who was caught in the uprising in Jos and martyred for his faith.

Darlington reports:

“The gory story of how our brother John was killed emerged this morning. We have gone round the hospitals in search of his remains but to no avail.”

“One of his colleagues was taking him home on a motor bike. About 100 Muslim youths waylaid them and wanted them to proclaim that they have become Muslims. The rider of the motor bike did, but John refused to follow suit. He maintained that he was a Christian and would die a Christian. Right there they cut him down, gave the other one machete cuts and let him go.”

“The surviving colleague of John’s told us the story. Unfortunately his body must have been among hundreds of others given mass burial.”

“We are obviously proud of our late brother, John, who stood gallantly and refused to deny Christ even in the face of death. The truth is that after confirming John’s death, I wanted to retaliate! But just this morning, I suddenly realized that John’s killers actually need help! And that we have something more powerful than the atomic bomb — the Word of God! So in our Bible class today, we shall be going out with *Riding the Death Train, Comfort in Suffering* and packs of drinking water, to camps where internally displaced persons are kept. No fears, just keep praying for us, that’s all our request. Soldiers on the streets will get water and “*Riding the Death Train, too!*”

As of this writing the city is still on curfew. Please pray for them.

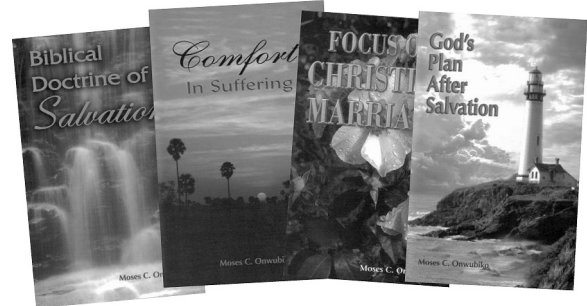
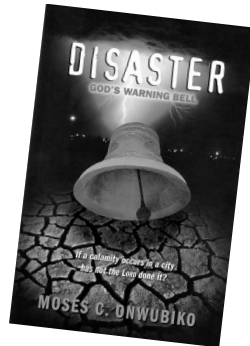

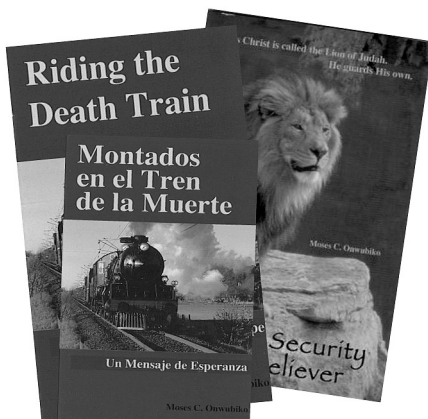
